DIRECTIONS

- Take Route 322 West out of West Chester
- At the light, take 162 West toward Marshallton for 3.7 miles to "Y" in road
- Bear left onto Northbrook Road and follow winding road
- Go approximately 2.2 miles to Northbrook Canoe Company

LENGTH OF CHALLENGE

9.5 miles, Mortonville to Northbrook

OFFICIAL RULES

- A **RELEASE/REGISTRATION** form must be sign-ed by each participant regardless of whether the canoe is privately owned or a rental.
- The maximum per canoe is 2 adults. Children under age 10 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Private canoe owners must provide their own life jackets and paddles.
- Participants must portage on the right side of the dam or they will be disqualified.
- Teams consist of **exactly FOUR** canoes.
- Alcoholic beverages prohibited on the waterway.

ENTRY APPLICATION

You must register in advance. All entry fee proceeds will be donated to the Cerebral Palsy Association and are tax deductible.
