By coordinating home and community based services to nearly 400 people with disabilities we have saved Pennsylvania an estimated \$7 million in nursing home expense.

99% of adults with disabilities in our program live in the community and continue to avert a nursing home placement.

99% of families report they are more knowledgeable about healthy child development than before starting with our program.

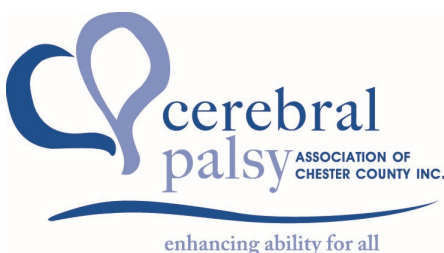
We provided over 1,158 individualized home visits to adults with disabilities.
