

Dear Friends and Supporters,



- 1 out of 3 toddlers “test out” of our Children’s Program, no longer needing supports.
- If you have a disability or are newly disabled, we can help you access and understand supports that may be available to you in Chester County and the suburbs.
- We loan or give disability related equipment that is either new or gently used for short or long term needs!
- We provided PPE to our adults with disabilities and ensured their safety!
- We provided a “pop up” program called Remotely Social encouraging our adult community to share their experiences on social media!

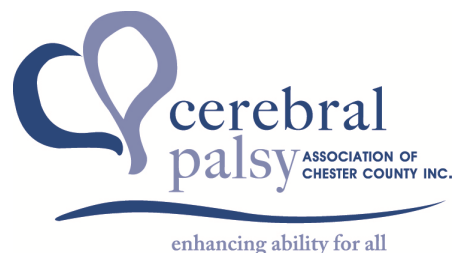
